A man working as a roadside shoemaker in Gorakhpur expressed his desire to help and with great pleasure began to take on the responsibility of delivering rations to some persons from his house every day. In Rajasthan, when the workers of Sewa Bharati reached to help Garia Lohar community, they refused to take help and collected an amount of fifty-one thousand rupees from within their community and handed to the workers to support the good works of Sewa Bharati. A fruit seller in Maharashtra donated his fruit to our volunteers. There are many such instances where people accepted to work beyond their capacity. In Nagaland and Meghalaya, the administration highly praised the work of Sewa Bharati. In the border areas of Manipur, Sewa Bharati workers took over the distribution of relief materials to help everyone.





There are few inspirational stories in this period which is shared here:


- 1. Migrant labor support center at Kanpur:** In Kanpur, along the highway a relief centre was opened to provide medical assistance, food and other support. Sleepers were also distributed to the needy people.
- 2. Support in trains:** Food, water and medicines were provided to the whole train going to Dimapur from Delhi. The support was provided in Siliguri, West Bengal the whole train was served 1635 Passengers.
- 3. Conveyance is arranged:** In Andhra and Telangana, State Sewa Bharati has arranged Bus facility to send the migrant labor back home with proper government approval.
- 4. Local conveyance for station:** In Punjab, Sewa Bharati arranged local conveyance to the people to catch trains from the station.
- 5. Dedicated food distribution facility for migrant labor:** In Gujrat, state Sewa Bharati started serving food to migrant labor colonies to ensure that they need not to move towards their home.
- 6. Food support to migrant labor:** In Delhi, the migrant labor in great number came to ISBT in search of Bus towards their home. Delhi Sewa Bharati and Noida Sewa Bharati came to help these people and provided water and food.
- 7. Monetary help:** A sister and brother walked from Rajasthan to their home in Madhya Pradesh. They spent their money in the road and had no place to stay and nothing to eat. Rashtriya Sewa Bharati got to know about them through some concerned villagers who called on the helpline launched by Rashtriya Sewa Bharati (Sewa Bharati Delhi). The siblings were provided monetary help.
